Jung-Min Lee, M.D.	Deputy Chief and Senior Investigator, Women's Malignancies Branch, NCI, U.S.A	Dr. Lee is a Senior Investigator and Deputy Chief of Women's Malignancies Branch at the NCI. She is a physician scientist, awarded with prestigious NIH Lasker Clinical Research Scholar, and an elected member of the American Society for Clinical Investigation (ASCI). Dr. Lee is a graduate of Yonsei University, Wonju College of Medicine in South Korea. She completed residency training in internal medicine at the Albert Einstein Medical College, followed by a clinical research fellowship at the Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center in New York. Dr. Lee came to NCI for medical oncology fellowship in 2008. After completing a fellowship, she was recruited as a faculty at the NCI and successfully established her mechanistic translational research program for gynecologic cancer. She became an NIH Lasker Clinical Research Scholar in 2016 and was awarded tenure from NIH in 2024. Her work has been recognized by many awards including the inaugural Jane C. Wright MD ASCO Young Investigator Award, Ovarian Cancer Research Award by the Foundation for Women's Cancer, NCI Director's Awards for Clinical Science, and Federal Technology Transfer Awards. Dr. Lee maintains her research focuses on the scientifically driven clinical trials and translational studies in gynecologic malignancies. She now leads multiple clinical trials through Center for Cancer Research/NCI, GOG foundation, and NRG Oncology.
